Wright's works range from tabletop to large size sculptures using traditional techniques of gilding on wood, welded steel with patinas of wax and paint. Surfaces and elements are worked, shaped, forged, exhibiting the artist's hand and inviting exploration by the viewer. Wright also produces drawings in graphite on paper. The two-dimensional works are not drawings of sculpture, rather, they represent situations and shapes that carry over into the three-dimensional work.

Anthony Wright's exploration of landscape focuses on the points where man made environment intersects with landscape, both natural and architecturally derived.

Wright's decades long interest in landscape coalesced with his move to Texas. Here he was struck by the long unbroken lines where sky and land meet. This juncture placed him in a position of expansive perspective and limitless prospects for study.

These exciting works by a mid-career artist illustrate a continued journey that is both fresh and curious, implementing techniques familiar and new to the artist's oeuvre.
